

## A MESSAGE FROM THE RECTOR:

Dear Friends,

In our Catechism, beginning on p.855 of the Book of Common Prayer, we speak of four orders of ministry: lay, deacon, priest, and bishop. But in the medieval church there were twelve orders of ministry. Among the twelve orders was the ministry of ushers. Our Ushers, along with our Greeters, are among the first to welcome us as we enter the nave. Often times they help us find a place to sit; provide us with a bulletin so we may follow the service; assist someone when in distress; answer questions; assist people in coming to the Communion rail. Presently we are seeking to add people to the ministry of the Ushers at Holy Faith. We have revised our written guidelines and Doug Whitehurst has graciously accepted the duties of Head Usher.



On Wednesday, July 17 at 5:30 pm, we are asking all of our present ushers and all people who wish to consider joining that ministry, to assemble in the nave where we will explain the various duties of the usher, walk through the service, and then celebrate with a barbecue dinner in Palen Hall. Our ushers are notably friendly, helpful, and provide a welcome and warm atmosphere to all people who come to Holy Faith to worship. If you are interested in attending, please call Dawn and let her know so that we will have a good count for dinner.

On another topic, recently the vestry had a discussion about ways to encourage our high school graduates and college students in their studies. We have decided, beginning this Fall semester, to offer a Scholarship program to provide our students with money for textbooks. Applications are available at the front desk in Conkey House, and also provided in the weekly e-blast update.

On yet another topic, plans are under way for a year long celebration of our 150 anniversary. The celebration will begin officially on St. Francis weekend, the first weekend in October, with a parish picnic on Saturday, October 5, solemn High Mass on October 6, and the Blessing of the Animals that afternoon. The committee planning the year of events is also considering commissioning a life size bronze statue of St. Francis that will be installed in front of the Church on Palace Avenue. Please watch the Faithway for more details as they become available. For the 100 anniversary of the parish in the early 1960's, the parish at that time, commissioned our beautiful high altar with the bronze Agnus Dei. We feel a statue of St. Francis would be an appropriate and lovely addition to our neighborhood.

If you are traveling during the summer, please be sure to attend a Church service on Sundays. When you do, please bring a bulletin; the clergy all enjoy looking at bulletins from other parishes.

## HOLY FAITH CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES



**SENSATIONAL SUMMER CHILDREN'S ADVENTURES** begins soon, on Tuesday afternoons, July 9, 16, 23, 30, and August 6, from 4:00-5:30 p.m (*please note time change*) for children ages 3½ (*as of June 1*) through 11 years old (*please note time change*).
