

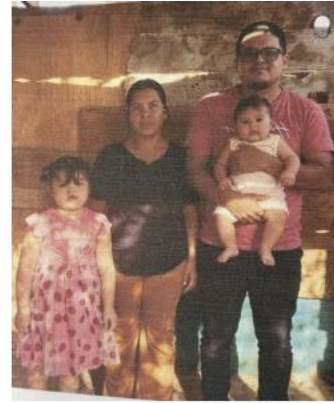

Family Story

Bryan and Karime are a young couple raising their two daughters. Karime has spent her entire life in this community. Bryan and Karime met in high school and began dating in 2019. After graduating, they continued their relationship and eventually decided to build a life together. Their journey into parenthood, however, was not always easy. Their first daughter, Edna, was born prematurely at only eight months. During those early days, they faced frightening moments when Edna struggled with her health. Three years later, Karime became pregnant again, but sadly, they lost their baby at three months. After walking through that loss, God blessed their family again with their daughter Sofía, who is now a healthy one-year-old. Today, Edna is preparing to begin kindergarten for the first time, and Karime shares how grateful and happy she is to have her little family. For the past two years, the family has owned a piece of land, but because of difficult circumstances, they have not been able to build a home on it. They currently live in a borrowed house. Little by little, they have worked on their property—putting up a fence, planting small trees, and caring for the land while holding on to the hope that one day they would have a home of their own. Their faith has also become an important part of their story. Karime shares that although she had known about God since childhood, she began drawing closer to church in April through her daughter's summer Bible school. She says this season has changed both her life and Bryan's as they continue learning more about God together. Karime stays home caring for their two daughters, while Bryan works hard to provide for his family, taking on different kinds of work, including construction, mechanical work, and helping wherever he can. When asked what she would like the team coming to build their home to know, Karime wrote: "I would like to thank you even though I don't know you yet, because I know God sent you. I don't know how to thank you for everything you do and will do for many families. May God bless you all your lives. What will be a beautiful home for us will be a beautiful house for you, where many memories will remain."
